Dr. Dionysios Tombros is an electronic engineer and has doctoral degree on the geostrategic importance of satellite networks for the acquisition of ground military information in the Wider Middle East region. In 2005 he was a researcher at the Defense Analysis Institute of Hellenic National Defence General Staff (GEETHA) and since 2010 at the Laboratory of Geocultural Analysis of Turkey and the Wider Middle East of the Department of Turkish Studies and Contemporary Asian Studies of NKUA (National and Kapodistrian University of Athens). In 2017 he was appointed senior researcher of the "Space Geopolitics" Sector of the Department's Laboratory. He has participated in several workshops and conferences and has made several publications. In 2018 he undertook the teaching of the course "Geopolitics of Satellite Systems" at the Department of Turkish and Contemporary Asian Studies as well as the postgraduate course "Space Geopolitics - Satellite Systems". He also undertook the course "Geographic Information Systems and Applications in Turkey and the Wider Middle East" as well as the corresponding postgraduate course "Introduction to Geographic Information Systems - Use in Systemic Geopolitical Analysis". In 2019, he undertook the teaching of the course "Military Topography, Satellite Remote Sensing - Geographical Information Systems" at the Army Military Academy, as well as the postgraduate courses: "Introduction to Photogrammetry - Remote Sensing" and "Special Subjects on Remote Sensing (Visible and Thermal Spectrum)".
