1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Pre-requisites for participating in the "ISS 22"

- Only military Officer Cadets with an appropriate military background are eligible to participate in the entire "ISS 22". Exceptions are to be addressed on a case-to-case basis.
- The Cadets' pre-requisites for participation in the "ISS 22" are as follows:
 - ✓ Language skills according to point 1.2.
 - ✓ Physical fitness standards as per own Institution requirements.
 - ✓ Basic managerial, communication and leadership competences.
 - ✓ Basic negotiation and problem-solving skills.
 - ✓ Ability to plan, organize and accept responsibility.
 - ✓ Basic IT knowledge (e.g. Basic Office Suite skills).
- Military Officer Cadets may attend one or more specific courses according to the schedule of <u>point 2.1</u>.
- Please be advised that civilian students are not to participate in the "ISS 22". Exceptions are to be addressed on a case-to-case basis as per each institution's request.

1.2 Language

- The entire International Fall Semester will be taught in the English language.
- The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) Level B1 or NATO STANAG Level 2 is highly recommended for Cadets' participating in the course.

1.3 Contents/Duration

- The "ISS 22" offers a curriculum of a total **30 ECTS** (4 of which are accredited from the CM: "Military Leadership C Physical Training", lasting 3 months). Thus, the cadets are eligible for Erasmus+ Funding (Key Action 01).
- The "ISS 22" takes place from **21 Feb 22** to **10 Jun 22**. (Any changes shall be uploaded timely on the EMILYO homepage).









1.4 Registration Process

For your convenience you may submit your application form without your flight information, however we kindly ask that you let us know of your travel arrangements as soon as they are available.

If you do use the fillable (.doc) format, please send it to 1LT loannis-Angelos LAGANIS (<u>laganis.i.a@sse.gr</u>) and in carbo copy (cc') to CPT Georgios KAVELARIS (<u>kavelaris.g@sse.gr</u>) by <u>20th Dec 21</u>.

- Key Dates to note:
 - ✓ Registration Deadline is 20th Dec 21
 - ✓ The "ISS 22" starts on <u>21st Feb 22</u> and ends on <u>10th Jun 22</u>.
 - ✓ Arrival is expected within the weekend prior to the Start date (21st Feb 22), that is, from (19-20 Feb 21) or the day prior the module's start date (if one is to attend one or more specific courses)
 - ✓ Departure is expected on the End date (and in any case no later than Jun 12th) and on a case-to-case basis for participants attending one or more specific courses.
- Every institution is encouraged to apply for no more than 10 participants (Exceptions may take place on a case-to-case basis and always according to the availability in effect).
- All application forms will be prioritized on a "first-come/first-served" basis. Thus, you are kindly advised to submit your application timely.









• Applicants from the same institution are highly encouraged to submit their applications collectively to further facilitate the administrative process.

1.5 Accommodation, Meals & Financial Info

- According to EMILYO-LoD 5 (framework), accommodation, meals, and other expenses in relation to the education are free of charge for members of European Union Basic Officer Education Institutions (<u>http://www.emilyo.eu/node/982</u>).
- For Non-EU Members administrative and financial (cost) details shall be based upon inter-institutional bilateral agreements.
- No tuition fees are required.

1.6 Permission for Stay

In accordance to national regulations, the permission of stay shall be requested via the sending Institution's (military) diplomatic chain of command.

A "Request for Visit (RfV)" is to be passed via the sending country's echelons to the respective country's embassy in Greece.

Please be advised that this process (RfV) is mandatory for all participants.

1.7 Transportation

- All participants should make their own travel arrangements.
- For cadets attending the entire International Spring Semester, be informed that your arrival is expected on Sun 20 Feb 22. Similarly, please schedule your departure from the Academy (end of the Semester), on Jun 10th.
- For students participating in one or more specific courses, you are kindly asked to be present at the Academy one day prior to the start of the course(s) (exceptions are to be reviewed on a case-to-case basis). As far as your departure is concerned, be advised that all classes/training sessions will be concluded by 1500PM on the module's end date. Please schedule accordingly.
- Transportation from Athens International Airport (ATH) to the Academy and vice versa will be provided by the Academy for all students/trainees. To that end, please notify the Hellenic Army Academy's POC's with respect to your flight information at your earliest convenience.







1.8 Uniform/Dress Code

- In accordance with the dress code in effect within the Hellenic Army Academy, shorts and denim trousers are not allowed.
- The following attires conform with the Academy's uniform regulations:
 - ✓ Arrival/departure and short leave: Informal/Causal/Very casual
 - ✓ Opening/closing ceremony: Ceremonial Dress and Service Uniform
 - Courses: Working Dress uniform (with and without tie) or Field Dress (dependent on the activity)
 - Sports activities: Own Academy shorts, t-shirt and tracksuit and swimming suit (for swimming training)

1.9 SARS CoV-2 Safety Procedures

As Covid-19 is still widespread in the EU, safety procedures and restrictions to international travels are updated on a regular basis.

Upon their arrival, all participants are requested to present a certification of COVID-19 vaccination. Alternatively, a certification of negative result to molecular or antigenic test, carried out by means of a swab no later than 48 hours before the arrival must be presented. The same test is to be repeated every week for non-vaccinated participants.

<u>Please be advised that all COVID-19 measures are tentative and as such, subject to changes according to the national health regulations in effect.</u>

Furthermore, please note that the Hellenic Army Academy will conduct a rapid Covid-19 test to all participants upon their arrival; prior to their entrance in the Academy's facilities.

Any additional and/or updated information relevant to the pandemic, shall be distributed timely to all participants and their respective institutions.
